I would like to thank the 117 parents who took time to contribute to our Parental Survey which was open to responses in April.

As a Leadership Team we use this information to enhance the experiences of our young people to ensure that their time at PHS is challenging, enjoyable and as supportive as possible.

There are a number of areas identified that we would like to address over the next session. Initially, we would like to highlight the following:


- School Communication: several parents commented that the level of communication received from secondary school is significantly lower than that of primary school. In addition to our termly newsletter and social media presence, next session we are returning to issuing planners to all pupils. This will allow us to send comments to parents and vice versa. Our Daily Information is also available to view on our website (https://www.portreehigh.highland.sch.uk).
 We will also inform parents and carers on a more regular basis through email.
- Parent Council: our Parent Council is open to all parents and carers and we would actively encourage anyone interested to take part in person or on-line. The next Parent Council meeting is on Tuesday 4th June at 6pm, when we will be looking at the School Improvement Priorities for next session.
- 3. **Mobile Phone Policy**: by looking at research and following support from the majority of parents, we wish Portree High School to be a 'mobile phone-free school'. We are currently working on a new Mobile Phone Policy to begin next session, where phones should be switched off whilst in the building and placed in lockers or bags. We have noted concerns from parents and carers that there may be circumstances where phones are necessary, for example for medical reasons. In such cases arrangements will be made with individual pupils and their parents or carers

Timetable Change and End of Study Leave

Our senior pupils have been on study leave this month, with the final examinations being held on Wednesday 29th May. We would request that all pupils who are returning to school for next session should be back in school on Thursday 30th May for an induction programme. The new timetable will start on Monday 3rd June for all pupils.




6. I feel that my child is safe at Portree High School






5. Staff treat my child fairly and with respect






7. The school helps my child to feel confident






8. I feel staff really know my child as an individual





9. My child finds their learning activities challenging enough






10. My child receives the help he/she needs to do well 117 responses





11. My child is encouraged by the school to be healthy and take regular exercise















14. My child was well supported to make choices about taking the subjects that are right for them 116 responses

























MOBILE PHONE POLICY

- 117 responses




Suggested Change to Mobile Phone Policy

3. If mobile phones are in school, they should be:

116 responses



- 34.5% suggest phones should be switched off in pupils' bags during lessons, with use at break and lunch
- 46.5% suggest phones should be switched off all day, either in bags or lockers
- The majority of the remaining 19% stated phones should be switched off all day or not brought into school at all
- Two parents emphasised the requirement to be used for medical reasons, e.g. diabetes
